

Our Rich History...

Nestled within 3,200+ acres of lush forests, Starved Rock State Park has awesome, seasonal waterfalls and 18 majestic canyons, carved by years of glacial meltwater.

Starved Rock Lodge is the only resort located in Starved Rock State Park. Built in the 1930's, the Lodge sits high atop a wooded bluff overlooking the Illinois River.

"Starved Rock" derives its name from a 1760's incident in which a band of Illiniwek Indians took refuge on top of a 125-foot sandstone butte.

The Park's Visitor Center offers an in-depth look at our history and tells how this area has been home to humans for 8,000 years! The museum is free and open to the public.

Trailheads Concessions is open daily during summer months and offers snacks, drinks, and Starved Rock logo wear plus a wide variety of souvenirs.

The Lodge's historic Main Dining Room serves breakfast, lunch, dinner and Sunday Brunch. Check out the Starved Rock Cafe, Back Door Lounge or enjoy outdoor dining on the Veranda (featuring the best view in Illinois).
















Discover the Eagles Tour

January & February

Waterfall & Canyon Tour

April & May • Monday & Saturday 9:00 am – 1:00 pm (Sat. only) 11:00 am – 3:00 pm (Mon. & Sat.) \$32.00 per person

Experience outdoor adventure at Starved Rock State Park with a guided walk to three spectacular waterfalls and canyons: French, Ottawa, and St. Louis. Tour includes lunch from a special menu in our rustic Main Dining Room, and a relaxing trolley ride. This is a walking tour and is not recommended for individuals with limited mobility.

Land & Water Cruise

June – September Monday, Wednesday & Friday 11:00 am – 3:00 pm \$41.00 per person

Tour begins with lunch in the historic dining room at the Lodge, followed by a narrated trolley tour with history and legends of the area. The trolley will then take you to the river boat "Eagle I" where you will see the east end of the Starved Rock State Park area by water. There are restrooms available throughout the tour and minimal walking is involved.

Dinner & Evening Cruise

Board a Starved Rock Trolley and travel to the river boat "Eagle I" for a leisurely, scenic cruise on the picturesque Illinois River. After the cruise, the trolley returns you to the Lodge where you'll enjoy dinner from our special menu, served with dessert, in our historic Main Dining Room.

Tour includes a relaxing trolley ride, hot lunch in our rustic Main Dining Room and a guided, scenic walk to Council Overhang and Ottawa Canyon. The walk is less than a mile and will take 45 minutes. This tour is not recommended for individuals with limited mobility.

Visit a Canyon with a Boat Ride

June - September Saturday & Sunday 11:00 am - 2:30 pm & 12:30 pm - 4:00 pm \$33.00 per person

Enjoy a trolley ride for a scenic, guided walk to one of our majestic canyons. The walk is less than a mile and will take about 45 minutes. The trolley will then take you to the Eagle I for a 1.5 hour boat ride on the picturesque Illinois River. This tour is not recommended for individuals with limited

mobility. Canyon chosen may vary, depending on the weather, river and trail conditions.

Autumn on the River

October • Thursday & Friday 11:00 am – 3:00 pm

Tour begins with lunch in the historic Main Dining Room at the Lodge, followed by a narrated trolley tour with history and legends of the area. The trolley will then take you to the river boat "Eagle 1" where you will see the beautiful Fall foliage of the East bluffs of Starved Rock State Park by water. There are restrooms available throughout the tour and minimal walking is involved.
